

Educational Book on being a Police Officer (Being a Good Role Model, Fighting Crime, Providing Safety, Doing Good Deeds)

Tips on Topics and Discussions for Advanced Readers:

Saying I am sorry

- Why did Sam want to be a Police Officer?
- What does a Police Officer do?
- What are some Positive things about being a Police Officer? What are some Negative things?
- What happened to the characters in the story who couldn't get along with others?
- How does Sam set a good example?
- Who is your Role Model? Why?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Sam the Policeman with other Sculptlings Books, such as Laurence The Lawyer and compare the 2 messages.

• Try comparing the characters and their professions. How are they different? How are they the same?

Example: (Both characters are teaching others how to make good decisions and set a good example. The supporting characters learn to make better decisions in both stories. Both supporting characters learn to say I am sorry and forgive one anther.)
