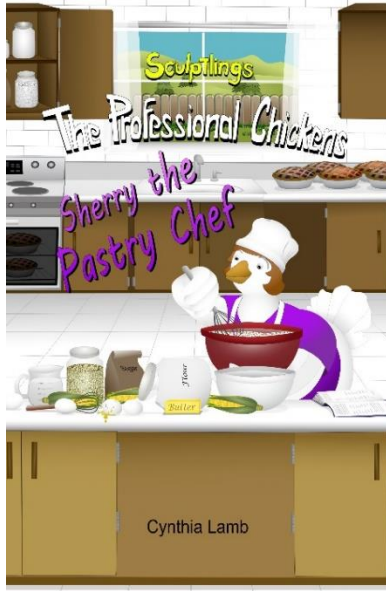

#### Entertaining Book on Cooking (Cooking Etiquette)

#### Ideas for how to review this book with kids 3-6:

- What was the message of the story? Have the child retell the story in their own words.
- Go back to each page and describe what is going on.
- Questions:
  - Why was Sherry running late to the big contest
  - Why is it so important to clean up after yourself in the kitchen?
  - What happens to Sherry when she leaves a big mess in the kitchen?

#### Tips on Topics and Discussions for Advanced Readers:

- What could Sherry have done differently in order to make more pies?

#### Compare Books

Try comparing the story Sherry the Chef with other Sculptlings Books, such as Freddy the Fruity Mouse and compare the 2 messages.

- Try comparing the characters. What do they have in common? What are their differences? Example: Both Characters get distracted and makes a big mess. They are not thinking of the consequences of the mess.
