Entertaining Book on Cooking (Cooking Etiquette)

Sherry wants to enter a contest but she spends her whole day cleaning. With no time to cook, she enters a contest with just one pie.

Sherry's positive message is on cooking etiquette and why having a clean kitchen is so important..

Book Topics

- Cooking Etiquette
- Importance of Cleaning
- Time Management

Ideas for how to review this book with kids 3-6:

- What was the message of the story? Have the child retell the story in their own words.
- Go back to each page and describe what is going on.
- Questions:
- Why was Sherry running late to the big contest
- Why is it so important to clean up after yourself in the kitchen?
- What happens to Sherry when she leaves a big mess in the kitchen?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Sherry the Chef with other Sculptlings Books, such as Freddy the Fruity Mouse and compare the 2 messages.

• Try comparing the characters. What do they have in common? What are their differences? Example: Both Characters get distracted and makes a big mess. They are not thinking of the consequences of the mess.
