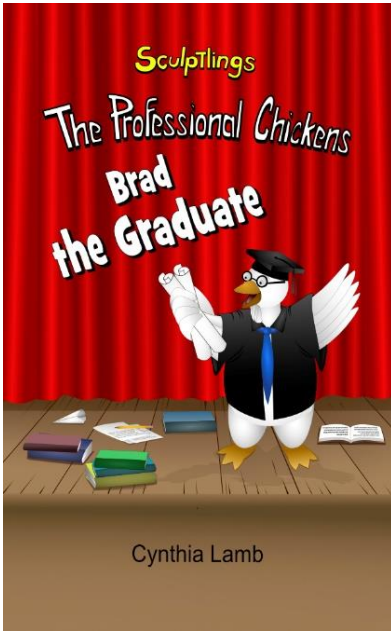

- What happens to the supporting character when he followed Brad’s advice?
- What does Brad say about failure?
- Why does Brad warn us about distractions?
- What stops you from concentrating in school?
- How can you make learning fun?
- What does success mean to you?
- What do you want to be when you graduate?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Brad the Graduate with other Sculptlings Books, such as Lee the Ukulele Player and compare the 2 messages.

- Try comparing the characters and their lessons. How are they different? How are they the same? Example: Both Characters teach others how to succeed. There are distractions in both stories while others are trying to learn and behave.
