Tips on Topics and Discussions for Advanced Readers:

- Why is it so important to keep a clean kitchen?
- What happens to Sherry when she leaves a big mess in her kitchen?
- Why is Sherry late to the big contest?
- What could Sherry have done differently in order to make more pies?
- Why did Sherry need to make more pies?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Sherry the Chef with other Sculptlings Books, such as Freddy the Fruity Mouse and compare the 2 messages.

• Try comparing the characters. What do they have in common? What are their differences? Example: Both Characters get distracted and makes a big mess. They are not thinking of the consequences of the mess.
