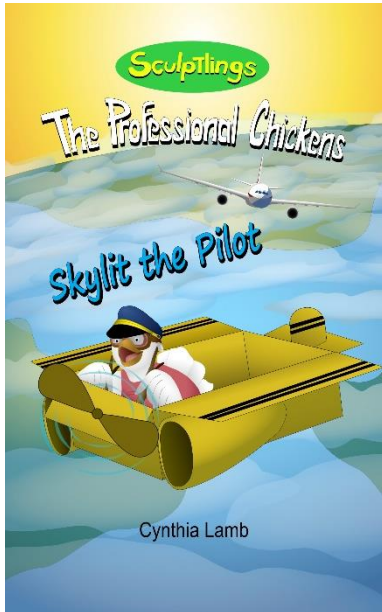


Skylit the Pilot

- Try comparing the characters and their lessons. How are they different? How are they the same?
