

- What does Freddy do that gets him in trouble?
- What is the Cause and Effect of the main characters actions?
- What lesson does Freddy learn at the end of the story?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Freddy The Fruity Mouse with other Sculptlings Books, such as Kent the Manipulative Mouse and compare the 2 messages.

 Try comparing the characters and their lessons. How are they different? How are they the same? Example: Both Characters try to be funny by being sneaky. Kent try's to open gifts and Freddy try's to create jokes. Both characters make a mess while playing around and get into trouble.
