- What does Patty decide to do about the pollution?
- What was Patty's solution for helping the environment?
- What are some things that you could do to help the environment?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Patty the Paddleboarder with other Sculptlings Books, such as Jay the Stingray and compare the 2 messages.

Try comparing the characters and their lessons. How are they different? How are they the same?
(Example: Both Patty and Jay have a problem with pollution in the water. They both end up helping marine life who get caught in fishing lines. They both are looking for a solution to prevent pollution.)
