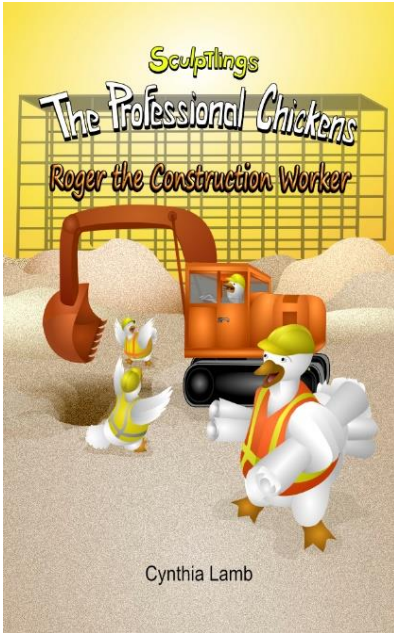

Tips on Topics and Discussions for Advanced Readers: Kids 6-7:

- What are some of problems that Roger has in the story?
- Why is it important to get along with others?
- What type of consequences happen in the story when Roger's Team is not getting along?
- What can you accomplish if you had a team working together to help you?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Roger the Construction Worker with other Sculptlings Books, such as Byron the Fireman and compare the 2 messages.

- Try comparing the characters and their lessons. How are they different? How are they the same? (Example: Both characters are in charge. Both professions work together to get the job done.)
