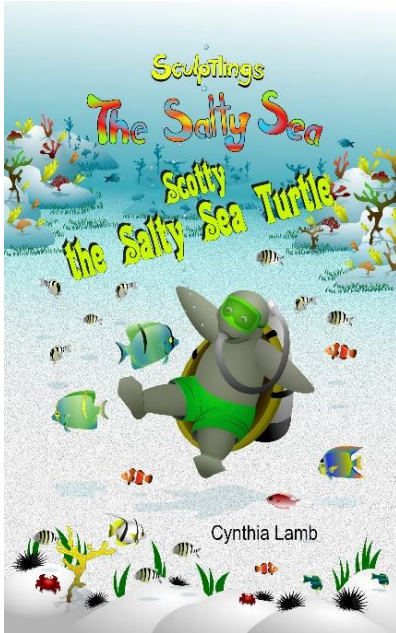


Scotty the Salty Sea Turtle

Scotty teaches kids to respect the ocean and its environment as well as protecting themselves from harmful situations. Kids learn to be aware of their surroundings and to always swim with a buddy.

Book Topics

Ideas for how to review this book with kids 2-5:

- What was the message of the story?
- Have the child retell the story in their own words.
- Go back to each page and have the child describe what is going on.
- What words in the story Rhyme?

Tips on Topics and Discussions for Advanced Readers:

- What does Scotty do before he starts traveling?
- Why is preparing before a trip important?
- What does Scotty see while he is traveling?
- What are some of the dangerous things that Scotty comes across while traveling?
- Why is it important to look but not touch when you are swimming in the ocean?
- Why is it important to swim with a buddy?

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Scotty the Salty Sea Turtle with other Sculptlings Books, such as Octy the Octopus and compare the 2 messages.

- Try comparing how the characters prepare for their adventures. How are they different? How are they the same? (Example: Scotty appreciates what he sees. Scotty looks but does not touch. Where Octy is greedy and takes everything he sees.)
