




## Compare & Reflect Ideas With Sculptling Books

### Compare Books

Try comparing the story **Captain Corey and Catlin** with other Sculptlings Books, such as **Skylit the Pilot** and compare the 2 messages.

Try comparing the characters and their lessons. How are they different? How are they the same?

**Example Comparison:** Corey and Catlin teach us that we can follow our dreams, no matter what others say, and that family support is important. Skylit teaches us that if we work hard and believe in ourselves, we can do anything, even if others think we can't.

### Ideas for how to review these books with your Preschool kids.

- Discuss the characters similarities. (They all dream of becoming captains.)
- Discuss the characters differences. (A boat captains drives a boat. An airline captain flies a plane.)
- Discuss the message of the story (If you believe in yourself, and follow your heart, you can be anything you dream of, no matter what)

### Discussion Questions for Advanced Readers (Ages 6–7)

**Help older kids think more critically and connect the story to real-life situations:**

- Create a compare and contrast chart with the students.
- Discuss the character traits in each story. (Catlin and Skylit are both leaders. Even when others doubted them, they kept believing in themselves. Catlin ended up being in charge of a big cruise ship. Skylit ended up being in charge of a big airplane and her crew.)
- Discuss the similarities between the characters. (They both had big dreams. They both love adventure. They loved what they wanted to do.)
- Discuss how they achieved their goals. (They both practiced when they were little. Catlin spent time navigating the boat with her dad and brother. Skylit practiced flying in her imagination and "taught" her friends.
- Create a writing prompt: *"What is your big dream and how will you reach it?"*

## Captain Corey and Catlin with Skylit the Pilot

### Compare & Reflect Discussions

#### Lesson Objective for “Corey and Catlin the Boat Captains”

Students will be able to identify the main idea and key details of a story and explain how the characters followed their dreams, overcame challenges, and became leaders.

#### Comparisons:

##### What do Corey and Catlin and Skylit all have in common?

- They all dream of becoming captains.

##### What is the difference between captains?

- A boat captain drives a boat. An airline captain flies a plane.

##### Who doesn't believe in their dreams?

- Catlin is told by her friends, "A girl can't drive a ship!" but she doesn't give up.
- Skylit is told, "You can't be a pilot, you're a girl!" but she keeps going after her dream.

##### Who Supports Them?

- Corey and Catlin believe they can be captains because their dad supports them and tells them they can do anything. He takes them on a boat trip teaching them the skills they need to become a captain.
- Skylit started dreaming of flying when she was 8 years old no family mentioned. (But in the illustration, you see a parent buying her a cardboard box.)

##### How do they both work hard at following their dreams?

- Corey and Catlin work together with their dad, learning everything they need to know to become captains.
- Skylit works hard and never gives up on her dream of becoming a pilot, even when people doubt her.

##### How does their imagination help them follow their dreams?

- Corey and Catlin have fun sailing on their boat, pretending to be pirates, exploring the sea, and learning how to be boat captains.
- Skylit imagines flying all sorts of planes, pretending to be a fighter pilot, a sea plane pilot, and a stunt pilot, before she becomes a real pilot.

**What Do They Teach Us?** Corey and Catlin teach us that we can follow our dreams, no matter what others say, and that family support is important. Skylit teaches us that if we work hard and believe in ourselves, we can do anything, even if others think we can't.



# Comparing Sculptling Books

## Captain Corey and Catlin with Skylit the Pilot

### Similarities Between Catlin and Skylit

#### **1. They are both brave and determined girls.**

- Catlin and Skylit did not give up on their dreams; they were both determined to make them happen.

#### **2. They both had big dreams.**

- Catlin wanted to be a boat captain.
- Skylit wanted to be a pilot.

#### **3. People told them they couldn't do it because they were girls.**

- Catlin heard, "A girl can't drive a ship."
- Skylit was told, "You can't, you're a girl!"

#### **4. They didn't give up.**

- Even when others doubted them, they kept believing in themselves.

#### **5. They loved what they wanted to do.**

- Catlin loved the sea and being on boats.
- Skylit loved flying and being in the sky.

#### **6. They used their imagination when they were young.**

- Catlin pretended to be lost at sea or on pirate adventures.
- Skylit pretended to be a fighter pilot, stunt pilot, or instructor.

#### **7. They both practiced when they were little.**

- Catlin spent time navigating the boat with her dad and brother.
- Skylit practiced flying in her imagination and "taught" her friends.

#### **8. They followed their dreams and succeeded.**

- Catlin became a cruise ship captain.
- Skylit became a commercial airplane pilot.

### Similarities Between Catlin and Skylit

#### 9. They proved others wrong.

- Both showed the world that girls can do anything they set their minds to.

#### 10. They are both leaders.

- Catlin is in charge of a big cruise ship.
- Skylit is in charge of a big airplane and her crew.

#### 11. They help inspire others.

- Catlin shows that girls can be captains.
- Skylit teaches others to follow their dreams too.

#### 12. They both love adventure.

- Catlin had sea adventures.
- Skylit explores the skies and faraway places.

## Captain Corey and Catlin with Skylit the Pilot

What's the Same?	What's Different?
They all follow their dreams.	Corey and Catlin want to be boat captains, Skylit wants to be a pilot.
Catlin and Skylit were told they couldn't do it because they were girls.	Catlin grew up at sea with her family and became a cruise ship captain. Skylit dreamed of flying and reached her goal on her own, becoming a pilot.
They dreamed about their future when they were kids	Corey and Catlin grew up on a boat. Skylit started dreaming about flying when she was 8 years old.
Catlin and Skylit proved people wrong.	Skylit flies a plane Catlin drives a cruise ship, Corey runs a fishing boat.
They all had fun pretending as kids.	Corey and Catlin had adventures at sea, Skylit pretended to fly over land and beaches.
They became what they dreamed of being!	Corey and Catlin had their dad with them. Skylit's story didn't include a parent.
They send a message: "You can be anything!"	Skylit and Catlin travels to faraway places Corey mostly fishes on the ocean.
They all love what they do.	
Both were <b>brave</b> , faced <b>doubts</b> , and became <b>leaders</b>	Skylit and Catlin's journey and setting were very different!



# Comparing Sculptling Books

## Captain Corey and Catlin with Skylit the Pilot

### Differences Between Catlin and Skylit

- Catlin's story is about family, teamwork, and loving the sea.
- Skylit's story is about independence, confidence, and loving the sky.
- Both girls had big dreams—and they made them come true in different ways!

Catlin sails on the <b>ocean</b> .	Skylit flies in the <b>sky</b> .
She became a <b>cruise ship captain</b> .	She became a <b>pilot for a big airplane</b> .
She grew up <b>on a boat</b> with her dad and brother.	Skylit started dreaming of flying when she was <b>8 years old</b> .
She always had her <b>family</b> with her.	Skylit is mostly shown <b>following her dream by herself</b> .
Some people said <b>girls couldn't drive ships</b> .	Some people told her <b>girls can't fly planes</b> .
She loved pretending to be a <b>pirate</b> and going on sea adventures.	She loved pretending to be a <b>fighter pilot, a stunt pilot, and a teacher pilot</b> .
She worked on her dream <b>with her brother, Corey</b> .	She worked on her dream <b>all on her own</b> and showed others it could be done.
Her story is full of <b>teamwork and family helping out</b> .	Her story is about <b>believing in yourself and being brave</b> .
Her job is about <b>sailing the ocean and having adventures</b> .	Her job is about <b>flying people to faraway places</b> .
Her dream came from <b>growing up around boats and fishing</b> .	Her dream came from <b>inside her heart—she just loved flying</b> .
