

### Educational Book on Teamwork and Working Together

Roger is a construction worker who works hard every day to make sure his team finishes their job safely and on time. He uses big trucks and works with many people. Sometimes the team disagrees, but Roger knows that working together is very important. He reminds his crew that by working as a team is how the job will get done. Roger's story teaches kids about teamwork, cooperation, and how important it is to work well and to get along with others.

### Book Topics

- Importance of working together
- Teamwork
- Getting along with others
- Helping each other

### Ideas for how to review this book with Preschool kids: Engage little learners with simple, interactive questions and activities:

- What was the message of the story?
- Retell the story in your own words.
- Go back to each page and describe what is going on. (Let the child share what they remember. It helps with comprehension and expression.)
- Discuss how everyone has a special job to do.
- **Activity:** Teamwork Tower: Using blocks, have kids build a tower together, emphasizing sharing and helping.
- **Rhyme Time:** Find rhyming words together. "Did you hear any words that sound the same?"

### More Ideas for how to use these books with your Kindergarteners to 2<sup>nd</sup> Graders.

- **Why is it important for Roger's team to work together?** (*Because working together helps get the job done faster and keeps everyone safe.*)
- **What happens if people don't get along or don't help each other?** (*The work can take longer, and it might not get finished. People might feel sad or upset.*)
- **What can you do if you and your friend disagree about what to do?** (*We can talk nicely, listen to each other, take turns, or ask a teacher to help.*)

## Discussion Topics, For Preschoolers

### 1. Who is Roger?

### Discussion Topics, For Kindergarten to 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

**1. What kind of work does Roger do, and why is his job important?**

*Answer:* Roger works in construction, helping build things like roads and buildings. His job is important because it helps make safe places for people to live, work, and play.

**2. Why does Roger say working as a team is important?**

*Answer:* Because when people work together, they can finish jobs faster, solve problems better, and help keep each other safe.

**3. What might happen if Roger's team didn't work well together?**

*Answer:* The job could take longer to finish, things might get broken, or someone could get hurt.

**4. How does Roger help when his team members argue or disagree?**

*Answer:* Roger helps by being the leader, listening to everyone, and making sure the team works together kindly and fairly.
