Compare & Reflect Ideas With Sculptling Books

Compare Books

Try comparing the story Sam the Policeman with other Sculptlings Books, such as Laurence the Lawyer and compare the 2 messages.

Try comparing the characters and their lessons. How are they different? How are they the same?

Example Comparison: Both Sam and Laurence are helpers. They both keep people safe and make sure everyone is treated fairly. But they help in different ways: Sam works outside to keep people safe and stop danger before it happens. Laurence works in a courtroom to help people solve problems with words and rules. But they are both use rules, kindness, and fairness to make the world a better place..

Ideas for how to review these books with your Preschool kids.

- Discuss the characters similarities. (*Both Sam and Laurence want people to do the right thing and treat others kindly and fairly.*)
- Discuss the characters differences. (*Sam helps before problems get too big. Laurence helps after problems happen, by talking and finding fair answers.*)
- Discuss how together, they show us that being good, calm, and fair helps everyone feel safe and happy! (*Sam protects people's safety. Laurence protects people's fairness.*)
- What do both Sam and Laurence teach us? (We should try to do the right thing and helping others makes this world a better place.)

Discussion Questions for Advanced Readers (Ages 6–7)

Help older kids think more critically and connect the story to real-life situations:

- Discuss what we learn in both stories. (*Helping others is important. Following rules keeps people safe. Being kind and fair makes the world better.*)
- How are Sam and Laurence the same? (*They both help people and teach us to do what's right.*)
- What do both stories teach us about behavior? (*They teach us to be kind, calm, fair, and honest.*)
- Discuss when we act like Sam and Laurence, we make our community a safer, kinder, and happier place!



Comparing Sculptling Books

Similarities between Sam and Laurence for Preschool

 - Laurence knows the law and helps people follow it.
- 7. They want people to do the right thing.**
 - Sam says don't lie, cheat, or hurt others.
 - Laurence says use your words, stay calm, and do what's right.

Differences between Sam and Laurence for Preschool

Let's look at what makes them not the same!

1. Where they work

- Sam works outside in the streets.
- Laurence works inside in an office or courtroom.

2. How they help people

- Sam stops fights and helps kids who are lost.
- Laurence helps people talk and solve arguments.

3. What they protect

- Sam protects people from danger.
- Laurence protects people from being treated unfairly.

4. What they teach

- Sam teaches safety, honesty, and kindness.
- Laurence teaches calmness, fairness, and using your words.

5. When they help

- Sam helps before problems get big.
- Laurence helps after problems already happen.

6. What they wear

- Sam wears a police uniform.
- Laurence wears a suit.



Comparing Sculptling Books

Similarities between Sam and Laurence for Kindergarten to 2nd Grade

- 1. They both help people.** Sam helps people stay safe. Laurence helps people solve problems fairly.
- 2. They both teach us to do the right thing.** Sam teaches honesty, kindness, and following rules. Laurence teaches calmness, fairness, and self-control.
- 3. They both care about fairness.** Sam stops fights so everyone is treated well. Laurence helps people make fair choices in court.
- 4. They both are role models.** Sam shows how to be helpful and kind in the community. Laurence shows how to stay calm and make good decisions.
- 5. They both solve problems.** Sam solves problems in the community (lost kids, arguments). Laurence solves problems with words and the law.
- 6. They both follow and enforce rules or laws.** Sam makes sure people follow laws to stay safe. Laurence knows the law and helps people follow it fairly.
- 7. They both encourage good behavior.** Sam says being good and helping others makes you shine. Laurence says controlling yourself and doing the right thing earns respect.
- 8. They both protect people.** Sam protects people from danger. Laurence protects people from unfairness or being blamed.
- 9. They both want people to act responsibly.** Sam reminds kids not to lie, cheat, or steal. Laurence reminds kids to stay calm and control their words.
- 10. They both give guidance for life.** Sam guides people on safety and kindness. Laurence guides people on fairness, self-control, and problem-solving.



Comparing Sculptling Books

Differences between Sam and Laurence for Kindergarten to 2nd Grade

Let's look at what makes them different!

1. Where they work

- Sam works outside defending chickens in the streets and neighborhoods.
- Laurence works defending chickens inside a courtroom or office.

2. How they help people

- Sam protects people from danger and stops fights.
- Laurence helps people solve arguments and make fair choices.

3. What they protect

- Sam protects people's safety.
- Laurence protects people's fairness and rights.

4. What they teach

- Sam teaches honesty, kindness, following rules, and helping others.
- Laurence teaches staying calm, using words carefully, and being fair.

5. When they help

- Sam helps people before problems get too big.
- Laurence helps after problems have already happened.

6. What they wear

- Sam wears a police uniform.
- Laurence wears a suit like a lawyer.

7. How they solve problems

- Sam stops problems quickly by acting right away.
- Laurence solves problems by talking, explaining, and using the law.

Says to be kind, honest, and helpful	Says to stay calm and think before you speak
Is a role model who helps the community	Is a role model who teaches self-control
