Educational Book on Importance of Working Together

Ideas for how to review this book with Preschool kids: Engage little learners with simple, interactive questions and activities:

- **What was the story trying to teach us?** (*We can be anything we want to be! Believe in yourself! Don't give up, even if people say you can't. Helping and encouraging others feels good too!*)
Reinforce that Skylit showed confidence, kindness, and determination.
- **Can you tell me what happened in the story?** (Let the child share what they remember. It helps with comprehension and expression.)
- **How did Skylit feel when people said she couldn't be a pilot?** (*Sad, mad, or maybe worried.*)
- **How did she feel when she became a pilot?** (*Happy! Proud! Excited!*)
- **Rhyme Time: Find rhyming words together.** "Did you hear any words that sound the same?"

More Ideas for how to use these books with your Kindergarteners to 2nd Graders.

- **What problems or challenges did Skylit face in the story?** (*People told her she couldn't be a pilot because she was a girl. Some people didn't believe in her dreams.*)
- **How does Skylit over come her challenges?** (*She didn't give up. She practiced and worked hard. She believed in herself and kept dreaming*)
- **What Kind of Perspective Does Skylit Have? How does Skylit see her challenges?** (*She sees them as something she can overcome. She stays positive and believes she can do it.*)
- **What does Skylit notice when she's flying high in the sky?** (*The world looks big and beautiful. The problems on the ground look smaller from up high. Discuss how things seem smaller the farther away they are. And bigger the closer they are.*)
