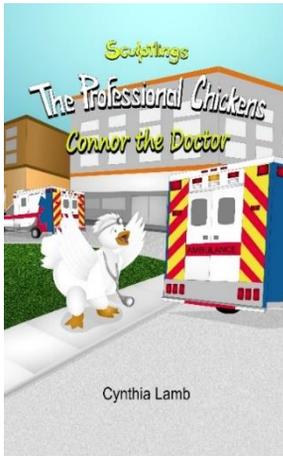

Educational Book on Doctors

Connor the Doctor represents many types of doctors. Kids learn the benefits of being a doctor and how rewarding it feels helping others. Understanding what doctors do and why they became a doctor is important. Connor's story shows how important it is to stay healthy, be kind to others, and help people in your community! It's a fun way to learn what doctors do and how their kindness helps people every day

Book Topics

- Types of Doctors
- What Doctors Do
- The Joy It Brings By Helping Others

Ideas for how to review this book with Preschool kids: Engage little learners with simple, interactive questions and activities:

- What was the story trying to teach us?** (How good it feels to be helpful. And how helping others feels good.)
- Can you retell the story in your own words?** (Let the child share what they remember. It helps with comprehension and expression.)
- Have the child describe what kind of doctor Connor is representing on each page.**
- How did Connor show kindness in the story?** Go through each page.
- Rhyme Time: Find rhyming words together.** "Did you hear any words that sound the same?"

More Ideas for how to use these books with your Kindergarteners to 2nd Graders.

- Why do you think Connor wanted to be a doctor?
- What are the benefits of being a doctor?
- Can you tell what type of Doctor Connor is representing on each page?
- What do you think Connor meant when he said, "Changing lives changes you"?
- Have you ever helped someone who was hurt or feeling sad? How did that make you feel?
- What would you say to a friend who feels scared to go to the doctor?
- How can being kind and helpful make someone's day better?
- If you were a doctor, what kind of doctor would you want to be? Why?** (Talk about being a doctor for kids, animals, teeth, or even feelings.)

For Pre-K Discussions

Let's Talk About the Story!

1. Who is Connor? What is his job?

- Connor is a **doctor**. He helps people feel better when they are sick.

2. What does Connor do to help people feel better?

- He gives checkups, helps when you are sick, and makes sure you stay healthy.

3. How does Connor make children laugh when they are scared?

- He **acts like a clown** and **tells jokes** to make them smile.

4. What kinds of things does Connor do to help families?

- He **listens** and **talks** to families when they are upset, and helps them get along.

5. What does Connor say about helping others?

- He says that **helping others can make their lives better** and it makes him happy too.

Thinking Time (Example Answers)

6. Have you ever been to see a doctor? What did the doctor do for you?

- "Yes! The doctor checked my heart and gave me a sticker."

7. How do you feel when you go to the doctor happy, nervous, or brave?

- "Sometimes nervous, but then brave when the doctor is nice."

8. What are some ways you can help someone who doesn't feel well or is sad?

- "Give them a hug," "Bring them water," or "Tell them a funny story."

For Kids in Kindergarten to 2nd Grade Discussions

1. Talking About Doctors and Helping Others

Goal: Help children understand what doctors do and why they're important.

Discussion Questions:

- What does a doctor do to help people?
- How does Dr. Connor make his patients feel safe?
- Why is it important to go for checkups?
- How do you feel when you visit your doctor?

Teacher Notes:

Talk about how doctors help us stay healthy, listen to our hearts, and check our bodies to make sure everything is working right. Encourage children to share positive or brave moments from their own doctor visits.

2. Talking About Feelings

Goal: Help children express and manage feelings like fear, worry, or bravery.

Discussion Questions:

- Why might someone be scared to see a doctor?
- What can we do to feel better when we're nervous?
- How did Connor help kids feel brave?

Teacher Notes:

Discuss how it's okay to feel scared sometimes, but helpers like Dr. Connor make us feel better. Invite kids to share things that help them feel brave (like holding a hand or taking deep breaths).

3. Helping Others Like Dr. Connor

Goal: Encourage empathy, kindness, and helping behaviors.

Discussion Questions:

- What are some ways we can help others like Dr. Connor?
- What could you do if a friend fell down or felt sad?
- How does it make *you* feel when you help someone?

Teacher Notes:

Highlight that even kids can be “little helpers” — giving hugs, sharing toys, or helping clean up can all make someone’s day better.

4. Staying Healthy

Goal: Teach healthy habits in a fun way.

Discussion Questions:

- What helps our bodies stay healthy and strong?
- How do we take care of our teeth, just like Dr. Connor says?
- What are healthy foods that help us grow?

Teacher Notes:

Use visuals or props — a toothbrush, fruit pictures, or exercise actions — to show ways to stay healthy.

5. Different Kinds of Doctors

Goal: Introduce children to the idea that there are many kinds of doctors who help in different ways.

Discussion Questions:

- What kind of doctor checks your teeth?
- Who helps you when you're at the hospital?
- Who helps when you feel sad or worried?

Teacher Notes:

Use this as a way to reduce fear of medical visits by showing that doctors are friendly helpers with special jobs.

6. Big Message: Helping Makes the World Better

Goal: Connect the story's main lesson that helping others brings joy.

Discussion Questions:

- What did Dr. Connor say about helping others?
- How does helping others make *you* feel inside?
- What could you do today to make someone smile?

Teacher Notes:

Celebrate each child's ideas — big or small — about helping. Reinforce that kindness and caring are powerful, just like being a doctor!

What are some of the types of doctors that Connor represents?

1. Dr. Connor the Family Doctor

- Helps you when you have a cold, cough, or fever.
- Gives you checkups to make sure you are healthy and growing strong.
- Listens to your heartbeat and checks your ears!

2. Dr. Connor the Dentist

- Takes care of your teeth and gums.
- Teaches you how to brush and floss so your smile stays bright.
- Says, “Open wide!” and checks for sugar bugs (cavities).

3. Dr. Connor the Hospital Doctor

- Helps kids and grown-ups who need to stay in the hospital.
- Works with nurses to help people get better fast.
- Might see you if you ride in an ambulance.

4. Dr. Connor the Counselor

- Listens when you are sad, worried, or upset.
- Helps families talk, share, and feel better together.
- Says, “It’s okay to talk about your feelings.”

5. Dr. Connor the Kids’ Doctor (Pediatrician)

- Special doctor just for children and babies.
- Makes sure you are growing tall, strong, and healthy.
- Loves to be funny and make kids laugh during his visits!

6. Dr. Connor the Helper Doctor

- Reminds us that everyone can help, even kids!
- If someone falls down or feels sad, you can help them smile again.
- Says, “You can be a helper doctor too!”
